ALL-TIME: The Southern Illinois Miners currently hold an all-time record of 764-566 (.574). They are 428-255 (.627) at Rent One Park in Marion, and 336-311 (.519) on the road.

LAST TIME: The Miners recorded their ninth straight win at Rent One Park and fourth shutout win in a row over the Evansville Otters, blanking the visitors 7-0 to move within 2.5 games of first place in the West Division standings.

Zac Westcott earned his league-leading 12th win of the season by striking out nine with no walks in seven shutout innings, becoming the second Miners pitcher ever to reach that total (Ryan Bird, 2008). Meanwhile, Southern Illinois' offense continued to do damage, scoring four runs in the bottom of the fourth to take firm control of the game before adding two more runs in the fifth and one in the sixth.

Individually, Ian Walters led the way with a home run, two runs scored, and two RBIs, while Nolan Earley and Arturo Nieto also drove in multiple runs as the Miners continued their excellence on their home turf, improving to 13-6 against West Division competition at Rent One Park.

GOING STREAKING: The Miners' nine-game home win streak is their longest since 2016, when they also won nine straight games in Marion from June 19- July 9. It is tied for the third-longest win streak at Rent One Park in team history, with the Miners having won 10 home games in a row three times, and a record 12 in a row once (July 30- August 25, 2011). They also enter tonight having shut out the Otters for 36 1/3 straight innings dating back to their victory at

Bosse Field on August 12, and have won five games in a row against Evansville for the second time ever (July 9, 2009- July 25, 2010).

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS STARTER: Chase Cunningham will be looking to bounce back from a loss on Friday at Florence. He had allowed just one run on two hits in four innings before permitting four runs on five hits in the fifth inning en route to his fourth defeat of the season. He has sparkled against the Otters this season, allowing just one run total in 21 innings over three starts with three walks and 20 strikeouts. He is also 4-2 at home with a 2.72 ERA, limiting opponents to a .199 average in nine starts in Marion.

EVANSVILLE STARTER: Austin Gossman will also look to bounce back after allowing eight earned runs on five hits with four walks in three and one-third innings against Windy City on Thursday. Before that, he struck out a career-high 10 in seven innings of one-run ball, but the Otters lost the game 3-2 to Gateway. In his lone start against the Miners this year, he pitched a complete game in a doubleheader, allowing four runs in seven innings while being out-duelled by Cunningham on July 17 at Bosse Field.

THIS DAY IN MINERS HISTORY: 5-6

2019: In the final game of the 2019 season, the Miners came back from an early deficit to clinch a series win over Evansville by a score of 6-5. A four-run Otters rally in the top of the first was answered by a four-run rally by the Miners in the bottom half. Both teams also scored runs in the fifth, and with the game tied 5-5, Taylor Sparks led off the eighth with his 10th homer of the season, lifting the Miners to the win as they finished 53-43, but one game short of the postseason.

MINERS vs EVANSVILLE NOTES

2019: The Miners went 6-6 against Evansville in 2019, including two historic sweeps. The Miners took all three games in Evansville in early August for the first time since 2009, but later that month, the Otters swept in Marion for the first time since 2011.

SIBLING RIVALRY: The Miners and Otters have had an intense regional rivalry throughout their combined histories since 2007, notably in the middle of the last decade. The two teams, the closest Frontier League franchises to each other at just 75 miles apart, have also had several links between the two franchises. Otters pitching coach Max Peterson was the Miners' closer in 2012 before getting picked up by the Chicago White Sox, and there have been several former Otters players that have gone on to all-star or all-star-caliber careers with Southern Illinois, including Tony Roth, Frank Martinez, Steve Marino, and Evan Mott.
