ALL-TIME: The Gateway Grizzlies hold an all-time record of 1,077-1,080 (.499). They are 608-499 (.549) at home, and 469-581 (.447) on the road. Founded in 2001, Gateway is one of five clubs in league history (Evansville, Washington, River City, Windy City/Cook County) with 1,000 or more wins.

LAST TIME: The Grizzlies capped off the regular season with a 16-8 slugfest win over the Florence Y'alls to win the series at Grizzlies Ballpark, tying a season-high with five home runs, and scoring in every inning except one to finish with 59 wins for the second year in a row and a 30-18 record at home in Sauget.

Florence jumped out to a 5-1 lead in the first 2 1/2 innings, but Gateway responded, scoring two in the bottom of the third on back-to-back solo home runs by Victor Castillo and Peter Zimmermann, then seven runs in the bottom of the fourth to go ahead 10-5, including a two-run homer by Jose Alvarez and a grand slam by Kevin Krause. They would also score single runs in the fifth, sixth, and ninth innings along with a three-spot in the bottom of the seventh to put the game away. Five Grizzlies had multiple hits, while five also finished with multiple RBIs in the rubber game win.

SETTING THE STAGE: The Grizzlies and Lake Erie Crushers went 6-6 against each other this season, with both teams winning two out of three in their home ballparks both times, including just last week in Avon, Ohio, where the Crushers won the last two games in their final turn at bat after the Grizzlies took the series opener. Overall, Gateway is in the playoffs for the second straight season after not making the postseason for 11 years, and are looking to avenge a tough Division Series loss to Evansville in 2023 while also looking to advance in the playoffs for the first time since winning their lone Frontier League Championship in 2003. The Crushers, meanwhile, are making their first playoff appearance since winning the East Division title in 2019, and just the second time overall in the last 10 years.

Tonight will be Gateway's first-ever winner-take-all Wild Card game, while it will be the second for Lake Erie, having lost in 2014 against Schaumburg. In fact, Lake Erie has lost seven straight playoff games as a club since their last win on September 12, 2013, having been swept in the 2019 Division Series by Florence, dropping the aforementioned Wild Card game in 2014, and being swept by Schaumburg in the 2013 Championship Series.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: The story of the Grizzlies' season can largely be written by one stat- hitting with runners in scoring position. In their first 26 games, they hit .321 (78-for-243), during which the team went 16-10. In their next 16 games, the Grizzlies hit just .185 (24-for-130), going 7-9 in those contests. Over their next 19 games, they got back to producing, batting .320 (65-for-203) and going 13-6. The remaining 34 contests in the regular season bucked the trend, as Gateway hit .251 (88-for-351) with RISP, but went 24-10 in that span. Their last 11 games have heped that cause dramatically, as they have batted .274 (32-for-117) in those situations, buoyed by a fantastic .438 mark (14-for-32) against Florence this past weekend, including 9-for-16 in Saturday's comeback from down nine runs.

GRIZZLIES STARTER: Deylen Miley enters the playoffs hot on the heels of a history-making regular season where the right-hander struck out a Grizzlies-record 161 batters, good for the second-most in a single season in Frontier League history and 26 more than any other pitcher in the league. The Ohio native faced the Crushers three times, posting a 1.88 ERA in 14 1/3 innings with 20 strikeouts, only four walks, and just six total hits. He tossed three innings against Lake Erie on Thursday, a start purposefully shortened in preparation for tonight's do-or-die contest.

LAKE ERIE STARTER: Darrien Ragins struggled with his command against the Grizzlies on Wednesday in his last regular season start, walking five batters in five innings and allowing four runs on five hits in what became a no-decision. It was his second start against Gateway this year, having allowed two runs on seven hits and one walk with six strikeouts in Sauget on June 21, also in a no-decision. Since beginning the season 7-0 in his first 11 starts with a 2.90 ERA, the southpaw is 0-3 in his last five starts with a 5.74 ERA around a mid-season stint on the injured list.

Last Time Out:
Tossed three innings to conserve energy for the playoffs, allowing one unearned run on one hit on August 29 at Lake Erie while striking out four batters to finish the regular season with the second-most strikeouts by a single pitcher in league history (Mike Recchia, Windy City '12 - 177)

Notes:

- Struck out a Grizzlies-record 16 batters in seven shutout innings in a win on August 17 at Windy City, fanning a presumed-Frontier League-record 10 batters in a row at one point while also setting Gateway's single-season strikeout record and taking home a second **Frontier League Pitcher of the Week** award

- Pitched a career-high 7 1/3 innings, retiring 13 batters in a row at one point with eight strikeouts in a no-decision on August 11 vs Evansville

- Tossed his fifth straight "quality start," striking out a career-high 12 batters for the second start in a row over six shutout innings in a win on July 10 at Windy City to earn **Frontier League Pitcher of the Week** honors

- Played three years in the Houston Astros organization, going 2-7 with a 5.81 ERA in 25 games (13 starts), 120 strikeouts (t-6th in South Atlantic League), and 63 walks in 88 1/3 innings at A-Advanced Asheville in 2023

- Posted a 3-8 record in 24 games (15 starts) with a 4.63 ERA, 111 strikeouts, and 59 walks in 83 1/3 innings at Single-A Fayetteville in 2022

- Had a 2.08 ERA in five games (one start) with 24 strikeouts and only five walks in 13 innings for the Rookie-level FCL Astros in 2021

- Played three years collegiately at Bellarmine University (NCAA D-II, became D-I his final season), with a 6.54 ERA in 12 games (11 starts), 86 strikeouts, and 33 walks in 64 2/3 innings in 2021
