**ALL-TIME:** The Gateway Grizzlies hold an all-time record of 1,018-1,044 (.494). They are 578-481 (.546) at home, and 440-563 (.439) on the road. Founded in 2001, Gateway is one of five clubs in league history (Evansville, Washington, River City, Windy City/Cook County) with 1,000 or more wins.

**LAST TIME:** The Grizzlies hit a trio of home runs and got outstanding relief pitching to come back from an early deficit on Sunday against the Lake Erie Crushers and conclude their regular season schedule with an 8-4 win at Grizzlies Ballpark on the Greatest Night In Baseball.

The Crushers got three straight hits to begin the game against Parker Johnson, and took a 2-0 lead in the first inning, but the rookie right-hander showed his mettle by retiring 14 of the next 16 batters he faced, allowing the Grizzlies' offense to make a comeback. Mark Vierling continued his hot end to the season with a go-ahead, three-run home run in the third inning, to give him an 11-game hit streak entering postseason play, and Andrew Penner also went deep to right field for a solo shot in the fifth to make it 4-2, extending his hitting streak to 17 games in a row in the process, the longest streak by any Gateway batter in 2023.

The Crushers loaded the bases and Sean Cheely's bloop double over first base tied the score at 4-4 in the top of the sixth, but Gateway responded with an RBI bloop single of their own from Vierling to take a 5-4 lead in the bottom half, followed by a three-run bomb by Penner, which gave him his first career multi-homer game and capped the scoring as Gateway finished the season 22-9-3 in series as well as 15-2 on their home field.

SEASON SUPERLATIVES: In their 2023 resurrection season on the field, the Grizzlies have:

- Made the playoffs for the first time since 2012, and finished with their first winning record since 2014
- Claimed their fourth West Division title in club history (2003, 2007, 2012, 2023)
- Were at least tied for first place for 103 of 115 days (90%) during the regular season, including 82 of those days in first place outright (71%), while going 46-23 against divisional foes (25-6 at home)
- Set a Frontier League record with 236 stolen bases as a club, smashing the previous mark of 204, with outfielder Jairus Richards stealing a league-record 75 bases individually
- Also finished inside the Frontier League's top-5 in batting average (.294; 2nd), on-base percentage (.389; 2nd), hits (954; 2nd), runs scored (626; 3rd), fewest strikeouts (646; 3rd), home runs (112; t-4th), and walks (428; 5th) offensively, but in addition, finished strong on the pitching side, with a league-best 883 strikeouts against only 327 walks (second-fewest), a 1.36 team WHIP (t-3rd), and a 4.27 ERA (4th)
- Dominated the comptetition at home, going 38-14 at Grizzlies Ballpark (the second-best home record in the league [Québec- 41-14]) while averaging 7.9 runs per game on a .330/.418/.542 triple-slash line

**GRIZZLIES STARTER:** Lukas Veinbergs gets the nod tonight in Game 1. The right-hander is coming off an outstanding second half of the season in which he went 4-0 with a 2.30 ERA and a 3.5:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio (42:12) over 54 2/3 innings. He also could not be hotter entering the playoffs, having pitched 18 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings to end the regular season, including a nine-inning shutout in his last start on August 29 against Evansville with a season-high nine strikeouts and only one walk.

**EVANSVILLE STARTER:** Braden Scott is coming off a victory at Schaumburg on September 1 in whic he pitched six innings of three-hit, one-run ball with three strikeouts, with one of the hits he allowed being a solo home run to the Boomers' Alec Craig. His prior start against Florence, he walked seven batters in 6 1/3 innings with four runs allowed, but allowed just one hit and struck out seven. Having joined the Otters in July after being released by the Toronto Blue Jays, he has not faced Gateway in 2023.

- Finished with a 6-1 record and 3.12 ERA in 17 games (6 starts) as a rookie for the Grizzlies in 2022, striking out 51 and walking 15 in 57 2/3 innings
- Pitched 14 scoreless innings with 15 strikeouts and just four hits allowed in his first two professional starts combined including a no-hitter through 8+ innings in his first pro start at Washington on August 2, 2022, to earn Frontier League Pitcher of the Week honors
- Played three years collegiately at the University of Missouri (NCAA D-I), going 1-4 with a 5.62 ERA in 21 games (three starts) as a graduate student in 2021 with 41 strikeouts and 26 walks in 41 2/3 innings
- Appeared in seven games as a senior at Mizzou in 2020 with a 3.00 ERA, 14 strikeouts and four walks in 18 innings before the COVID-19 pandemic cancelled the season
